

FSDA West Coast Council 2010 Spearfishing Tournament Rules

Please read all of the rules.

1) **Safety First.** This is a recreational series, we do this for fun. We are here primarily to enjoy each others company. Do not push your training limits or violate safe practice. The FSDA/WCC recommends that no competitors exceed the recreational diving limit of 130 feet depth.

2) **Points:** Each diver is to turn in **only their TWO largest fish** in each category, **except** AJ/Cobia/Cuda and Grouper categories, in which only one fish will be weighed. Fish are required to be gutted. A diver will receive one point per pound and one point per fish.

Grouper, AJ, Snapper, Cobia and Cuda over 20 pounds will count only as 20 pounds, for a maximum of 21 points per fish.

Hogfish, Sheepshead and Triggerfish over 5 pounds will count only as 5 pounds, for a maximum of 6 points per fish.

All points earned by all divers will be counted and accumulated for the entire series, regardless of their placement. For example, a last place fish will earn at least 2 points, one for the weight and one for the fish.

3) **Awards:** This year we are planning a total of four (4) day competitions with only the top three (3) day competitions counting toward the season-long Individual and Team competitions.

Day Competitions:

Individuals: Points will be totaled at the end of each meet, and trophies awarded to the three (3) highest scorers for that meet.

Largest Fish: A trophy will be awarded to the contestant with the largest fish in each category of each meet, for total of **five (5) largest fish trophies** per meet.

Juniors: A trophy will be awarded to the junior with the highest score per meet as long as 2 juniors shoot in the event.

Series Competition 3 out of 4 Day Competitions:

Individuals: The top three (3) day competition totals for each diver will be totaled at the end of the year, and trophies awarded to the *top (5) individuals*, and the *top female* diver and *top junior* diver. A top female and top junior trophy will be awarded at the end of the year if at least five (5) different female shooters and/or at least five (5) different junior shooters participate in any of the 2010 WCC series of tournaments.

Club Competition: Points will be totaled for the *top (10) divers from each club*, for each meet. Those points will be scored as *club points*. The top three (3) day totals for each club will be combined for the *season club point total*. The club with the highest *Season Club Point Total* at the end of the year will be *West Coast Council Club Champion*, their clubs name will be engraved on the perpetual trophy, which will be awarded to the club at the FSDA annual banquet.

Largest fish Competition: Five (5) more trophies will be awarded at the end of the year to the contestants who scored the *largest single fish in each category*.

In the case of any **Ties**, if only one of the tied contestants is present, then the Tied Shooter that is present will receive the award. If both are present, Ties will be broken mathematically by dividing each contestant's total weight by the number of fish. The highest number will be the winner.

- 4) **Prizes for each meet:** Each tournament will have 4 \$50.00 PADO gift certificates provided by FSDA. Each participant who weighs at least one fish will be automatically entered into the drawing for the prize(s). A random drawing at the conclusion of the tournament will determine the winner(s) of the prize(s). Entrants must be present to win.
- 5) **Gear:** May be SCUBA or Freediving. Electronic gear is permitted. No power heads may be used.
- 6) **Tournament times:** Tournaments begin at **7:30 AM**. All weigh-in line deadline times are **6:00 pm** (even if it is a rain date). All fish and at least one diver from the team that boated them must be in the weigh-in line no later than the deadline time in order to receive points for their fish.
- 7) **Eligible fish for scoring:**

- 8) **Fish requirements and penalties:** If a diver submits a short fish to the weigh in the diver will be automatically disqualified (DQ'd) for the day no questions asked. The diver will receive a zero for individual points and will not be eligible for any of the individual trophies for that meet.

All fish must be legally taken and **landed by the diver who is awarded the points**. The "weigh-in line" will constitute the physical location for the close of the meet. The weigh-in line location will be announced at each meet at the pre-dive briefing. All fish must be *physically in the weigh-in line by the deadline time*. If you have any questions about where your fish must be at by the deadline time, ask the Tournament Director at the morning meeting. All competitors' fish entries must be gutted, presorted, on individual stringers, and iced properly.

- 9) **Launch Ramps:** All pre-registrants can skip the mandatory early morning check-in but they still have to wait until 7:30 am to leave their dock. All participants and/or boat representatives who have NOT pre-registered must sign in with the Tournament Host club representative prior to the start time and leave from the host ramp either by boat or car, not before the starting time.

Please remember that these are public ramps. Entrants may be disqualified for any acts or behavior that endanger others, violate navigation laws, or embarrass the WCC. **Depart and approach ramps in a courteous manner.**

- 10) **Boundaries:** The east/west boundary will be the west coast of Florida, with no north or south boundaries. No competitors shall approach or dive closer than 200 feet of another anchored boat posting a dive flag, except on wrecks, in which case you must approach courteously without endangering divers.

- 11) **Eligibility:** Clubs: Application for membership must be approved by a majority WCC (West Coast Council) vote. All competitors must be members of the FSDA. Independents: individuals who are not members of a WCC club may enter as independents for two tournaments only, unless the top three scoring clubs authorize more dives by a vote. Independents compete in the individual competitions only and are only eligible for single event trophies not for yearend trophies. If a participant joins a WCC club before the last meet then they would be eligible for a yearend trophy. (If the participant joins a WCC club their individual points will NOT count towards that club's season club point total.) Juniors: do not have to be members of a WCC club, but must pay FSDA dues to participate. Junior participants must be under the age of 18 *on or before* the first WCC Tournament Date. The minimum age is 12.
- 12) **Tardiness/Disqualification:** The weigh-in line location and description is addressed above. The Tournament Director maintains the official time and is therefore charged with the enforcement of the following rules: **In order to receive points for the fish to be weighed, all fish must be present in the weigh-in line before the 6 pm deadline time.** Any participant presenting fish in the weigh-in line after [the deadline time](#) will result in disqualification. Also, adding fish to a participant's stringer after [the deadline time](#) will result in disqualification. If a boat is disabled (operating other than normal performance), one person from that boat may bring in all entries to the weigh-in. Any cases of cheating shall result in disqualification and loss of both individual and team points for the year and a ban from the following year's competition. Infractions of the tournament rules, i.e. rough play or un-sportsmen like conduct will result in a disqualification.
- 13) **Meet cancellation:** We will make our best effort to run the tournaments on their scheduled dates. The WCC Weather Committee will decide to postpone the meet if unfavorable dive conditions prevail. The Weather Committee's official decision shall be submitted no later than 4:00 pm the Friday Before the tournament. Consult www.spearfishingplanet.com, WCC section to confirm a meet's cancellation or call Aquatic Obsessions dive shop at 727-344-3483 between 5:00 PM and 6:00 PM the Friday before the tournament.
- 14) **Entry fee:** Adults: **\$100.00 pre-registration, \$120.00 at the first dive for all four (4) dives, or \$40.00 at each dive.** Juniors: \$75.00 pre-registration, \$90.00 at the first dive for all four (4) dives, or \$30.00 at each dive. (All pre-registration entries must be received by April 30, 2010) Individuals may pre-register for a single WCC event (therefore not be required to attend the morning meeting) if their waiver and money are post-marked no later than the Friday (1 week prior to the meet) BEFORE the WCC meet. Please make checks payable to the West Coast Council and should be sent to: **WCC Chairman, 131 88th AVE NE St.Petersburg FL. 33702.** Registration for the series can also be paid at the first WCC dive. No refunds will be given.

16) **Host Club Responsibilities:** Host Club will be responsible for helping setup and run the tournament, which includes the following:

- Providing coffee and donuts in the morning
- Providing food and drinks during the weigh-in
- Providing and **RETURNING CLEAN** scales
- Compiling the entry lists
- Providing weigh-master who is a member of host club
- Assisting with scoring results
- Submitting scoring results in legible form to the Tournament Director the day of the meet
- Assure that the area is clean upon departure and assist the Tournament Director

17) **Rules/Protests:** These rules may be expanded or modified by the WCC Chairmen if necessary, in the interest of safety, or for the benefit of the participants. Once the tournament series begins, any rule changes must be agreed to by both of the Chairmen and voted on by the top three scoring clubs. A majority will prevail. Protests may be presented to the Tournament Director at any time. The Tournament Director's decision will be final.
